Field Day at McKenny – Thursday, June 22nd We Need Volunteers!

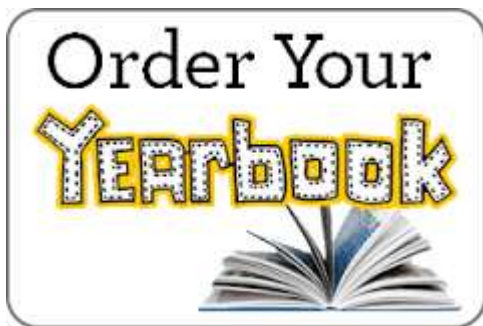

From the School Nurse – Attention Parents of Current 5th Grade Students

The Department of Health wants you to be aware of three immunizations that your child must have before entering 6th grade.

Tdap or Tetanus Diphtheria & Pertussis (Whooping Cough) – Your child must receive a Tdap. Make sure the school has the date of this vaccination.

MMR or Measles, Mumps, Rubella – Prior to kindergarten your child received a second MMR. If your child did not receive this second MMR, a second dose is required before 6th grade.

Varicella or Chicken Pox – Your child must receive a Varicella vaccination or have had Chicken Pox before entering 6th grade. Verification of the disease must come from a health Care Provider.
